Report says many Delco districts are thousands short per student.

UPPER DARBY — A county-wide public meeting will be convened on Tuesday evening to discuss the findings of a state-wide study on the cost of educating a child.

Representatives of the state Department of Education and

the company contracted by the state legislature to do the study, Augenblick, Palaich and Associates Inc., will conduct the meeting. The company was contracted to focus on the adequacy and equity of school funding and to determine what it would cost to give each child a quality public school education.

The report was released on Nov. 14. It gives an average figure for what each of the 501 school districts in Pennsylvania
